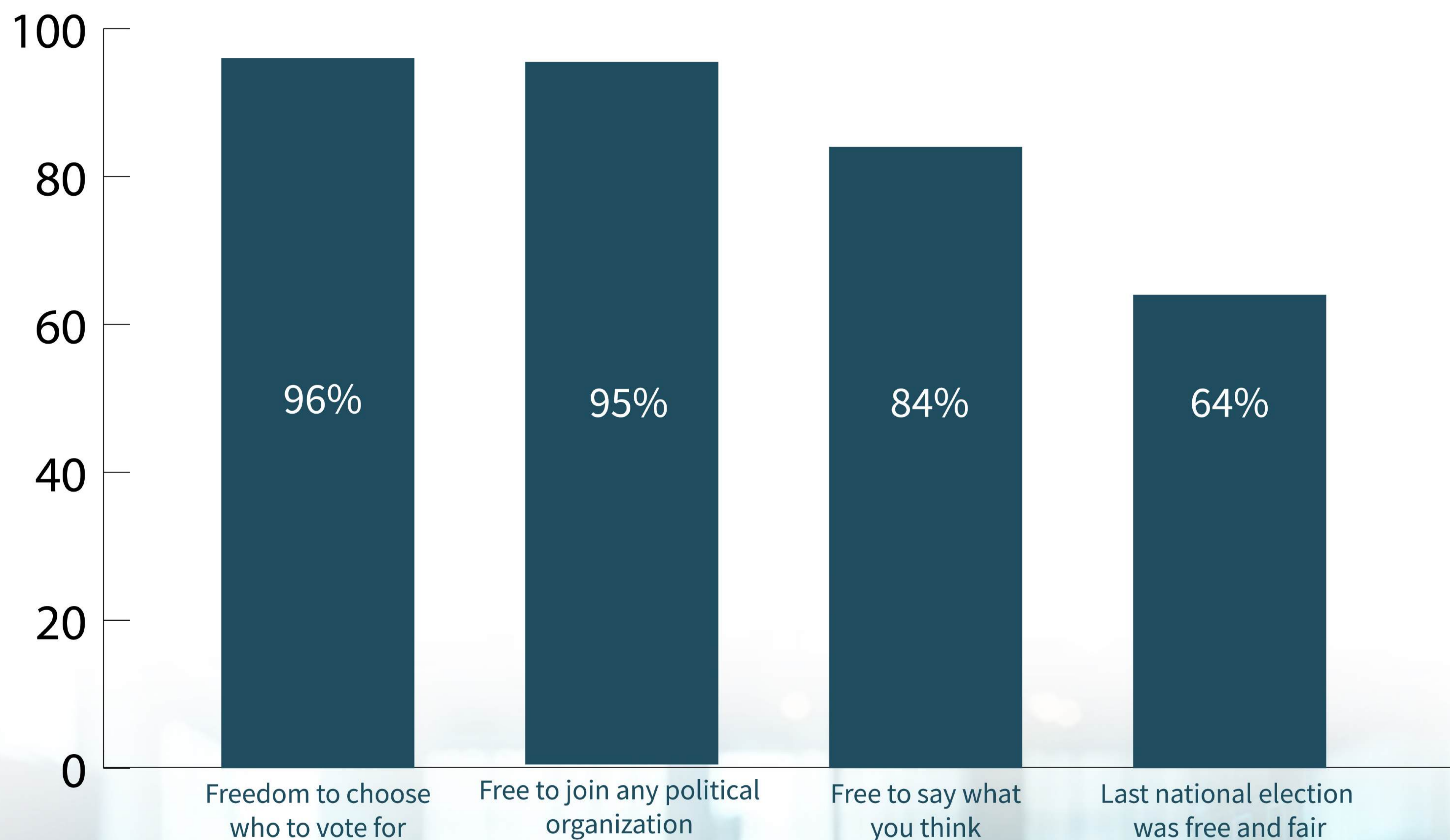

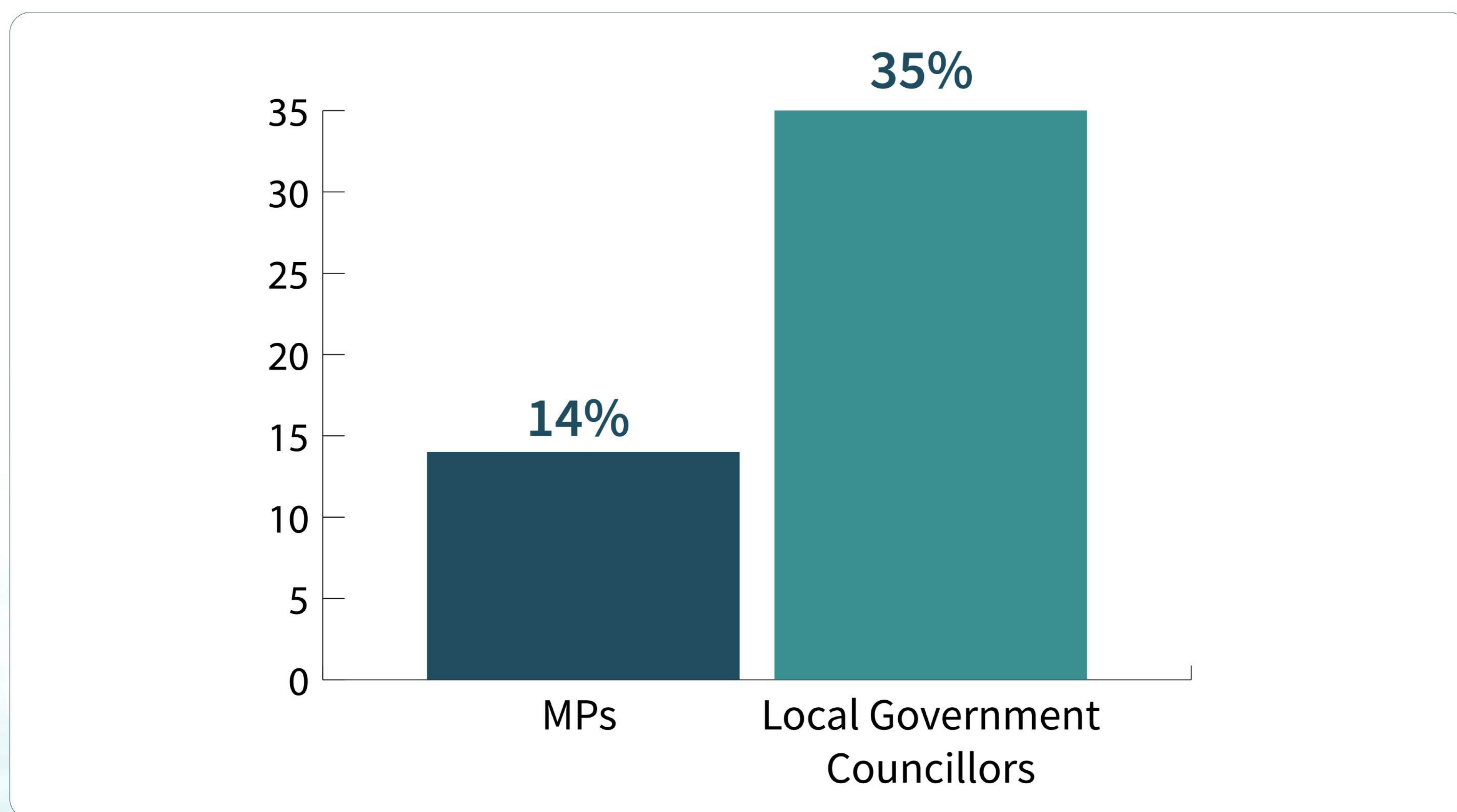
## Political Freedoms (somewhat/completely free)

## Elected officials often/always listen to citizens

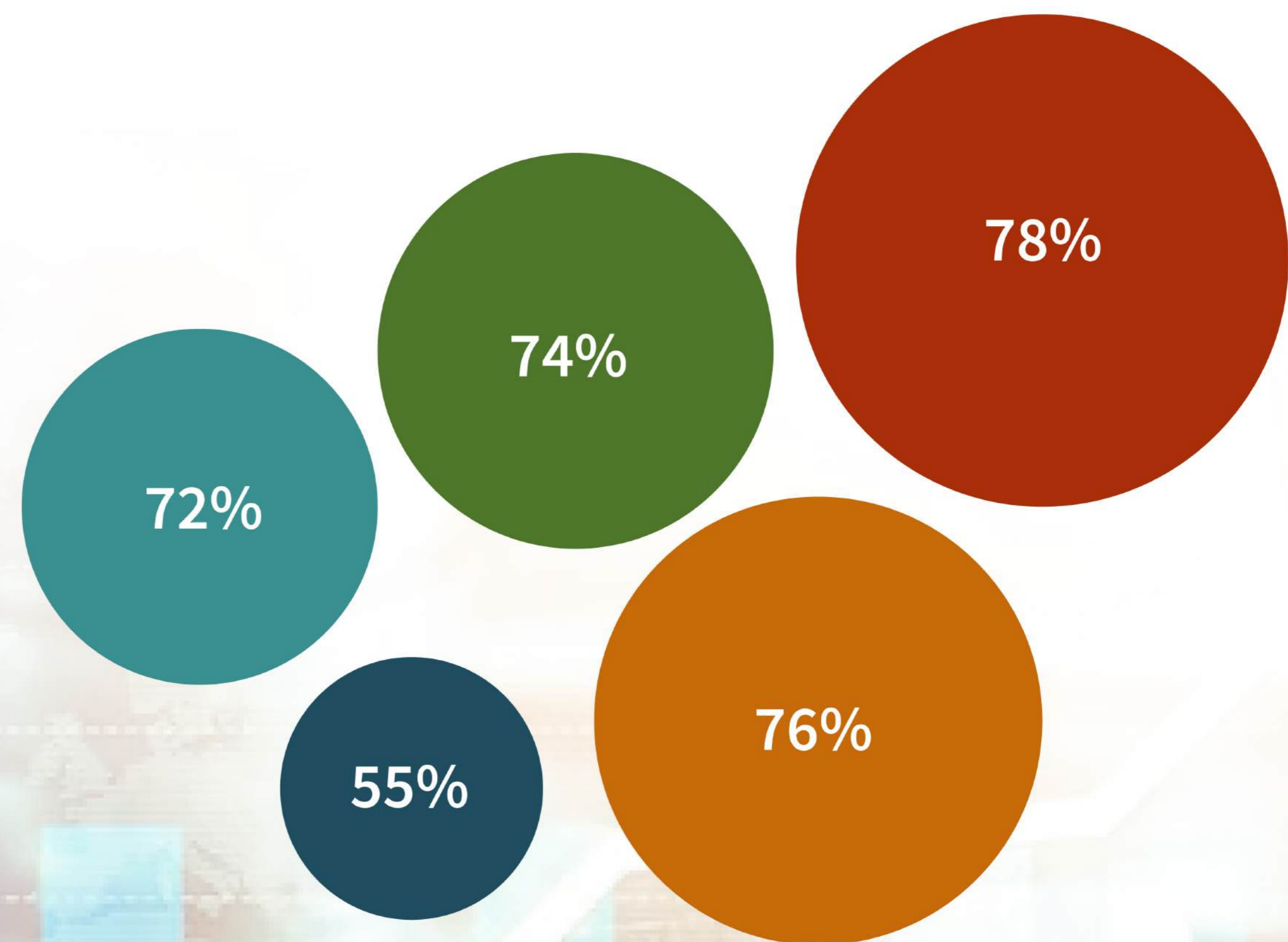

- Armed forces should never intervene in politics

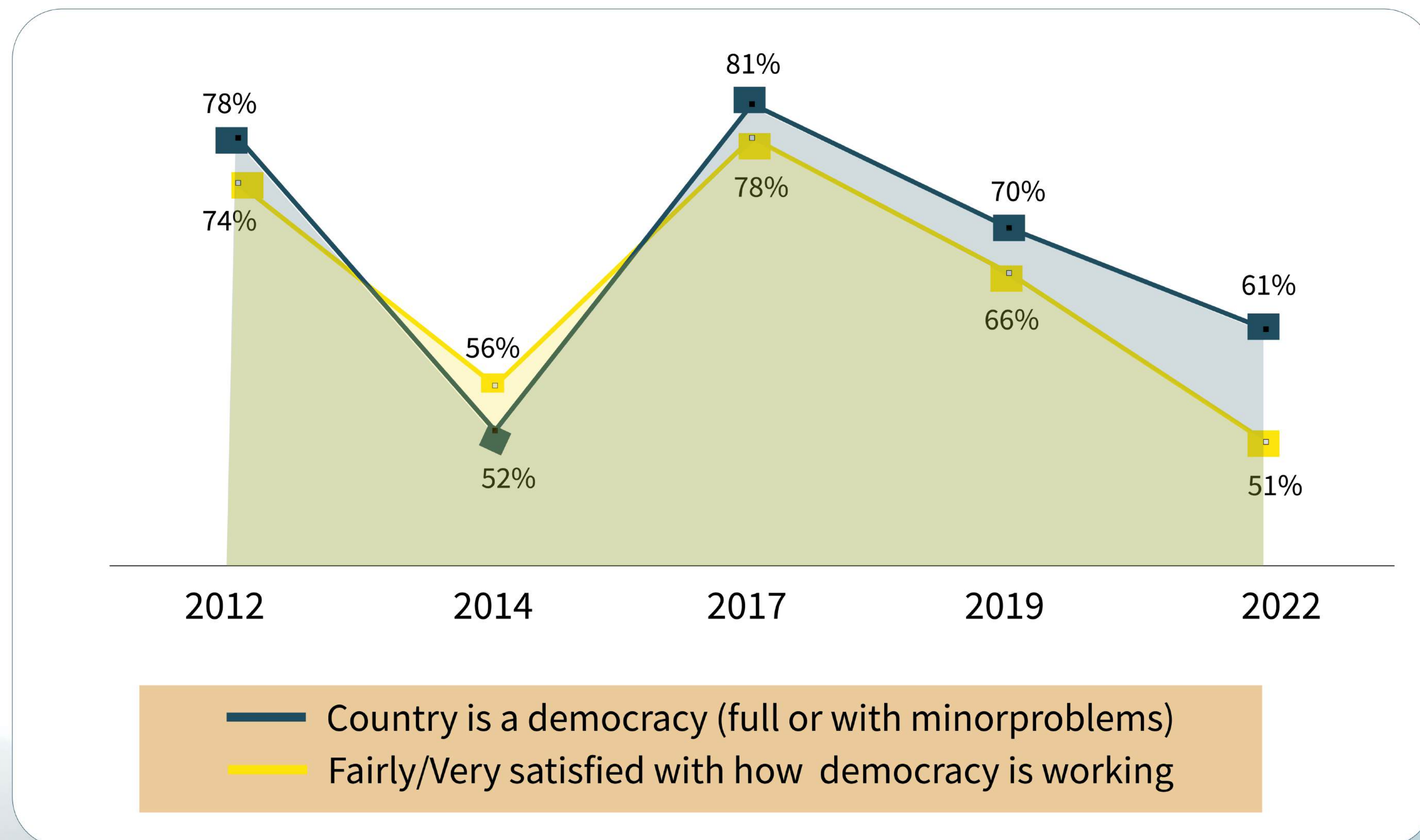

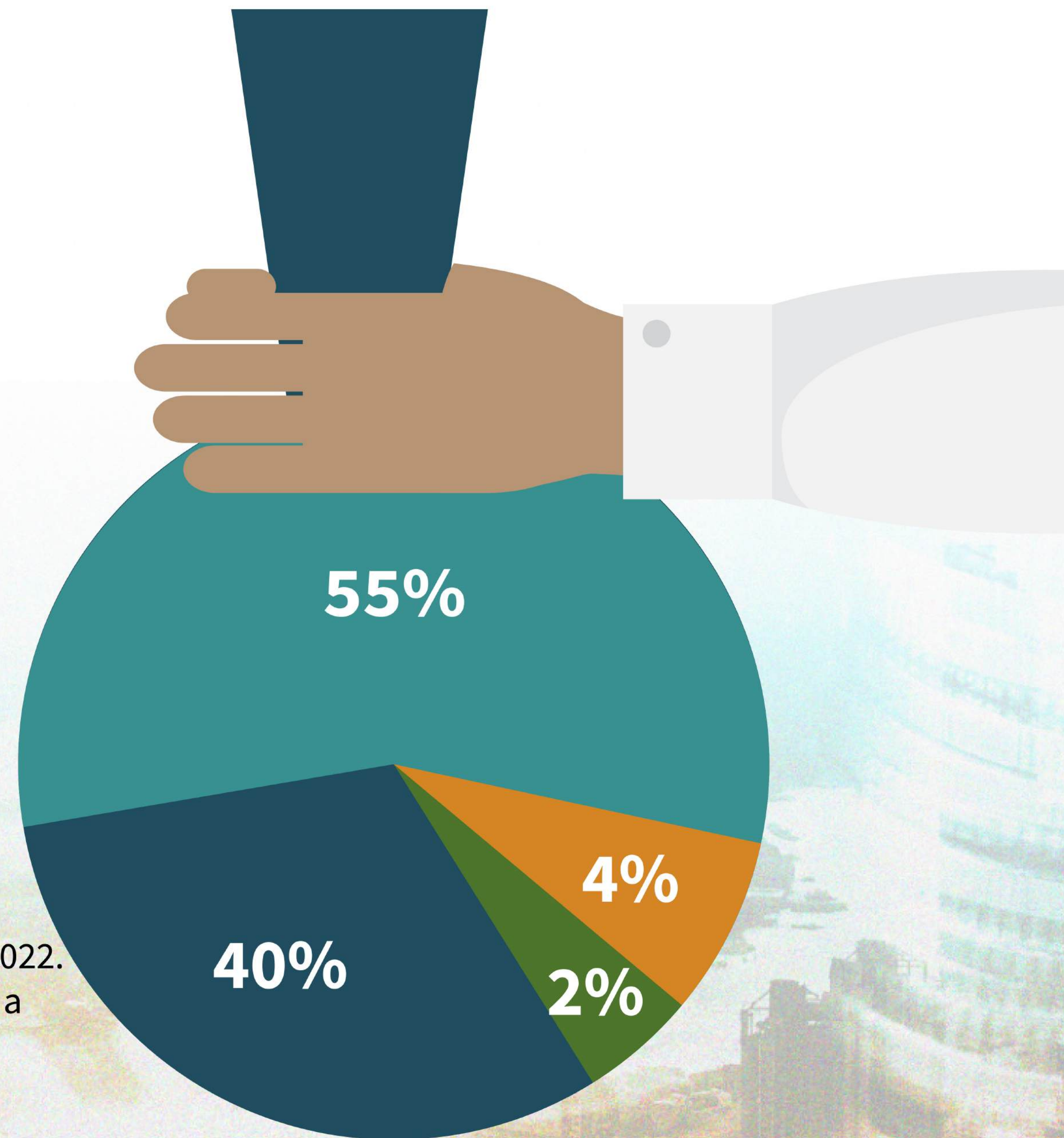
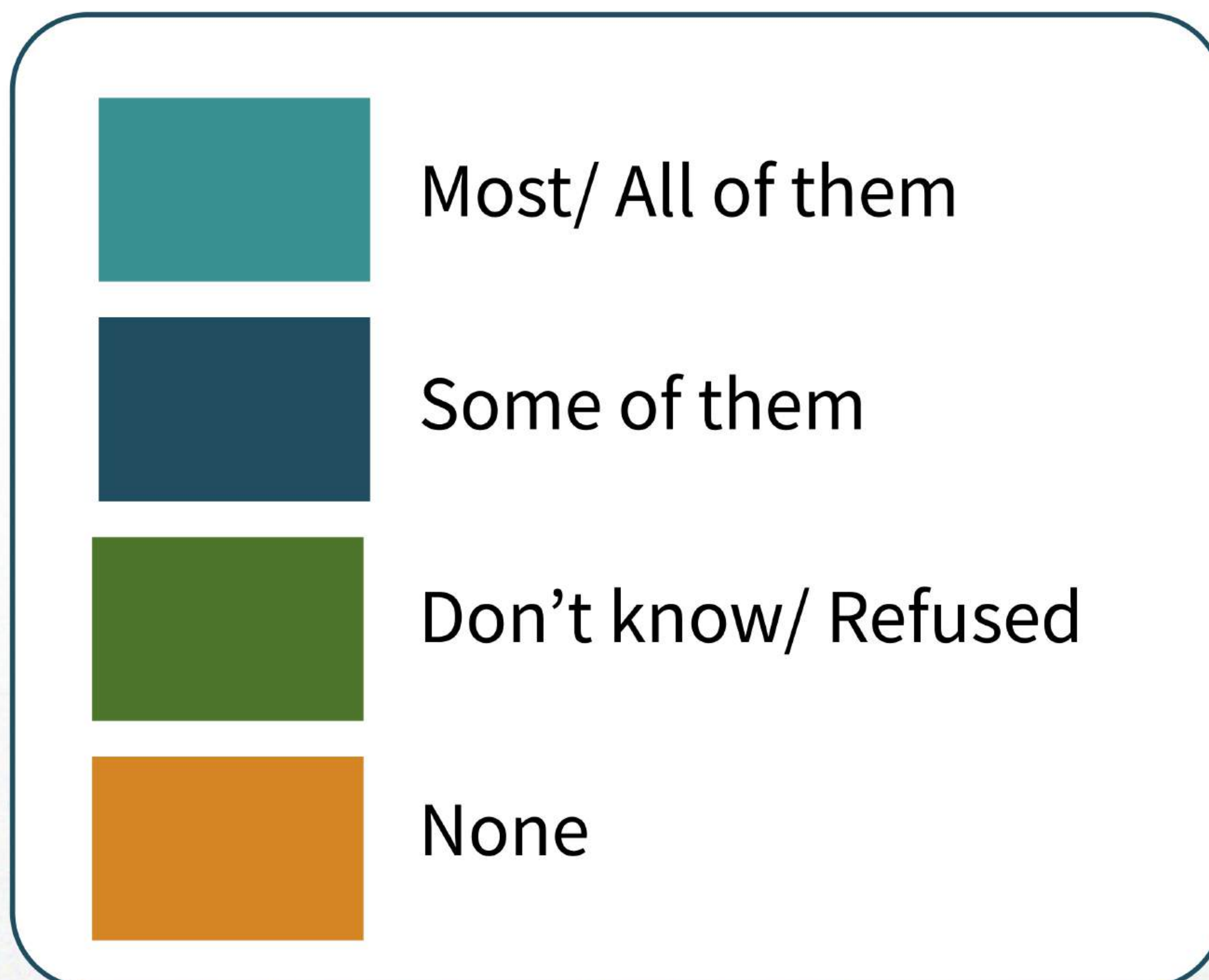
Extent of and satisfaction with democracy

## Corruption in the Presidency

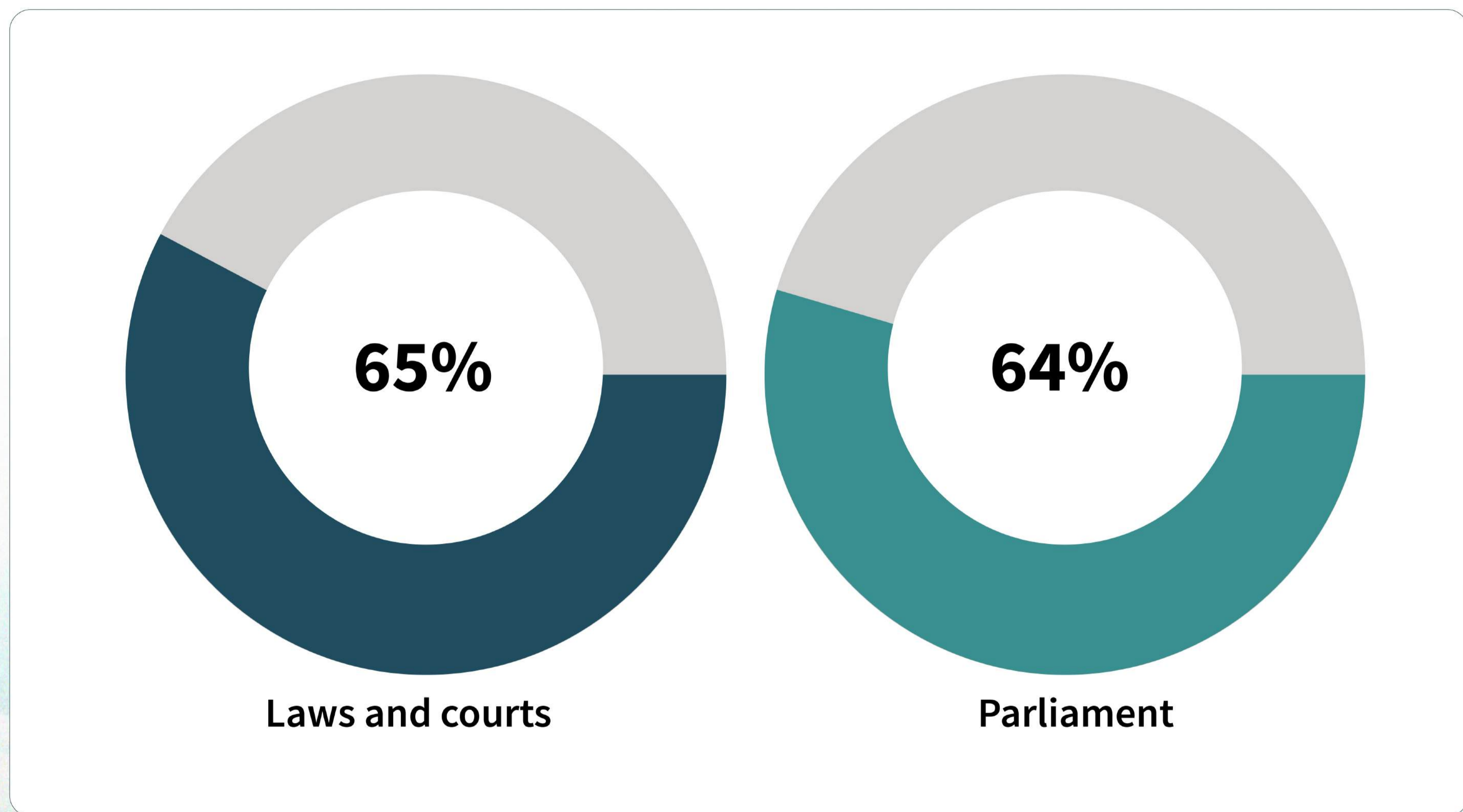

President rarely/never ignores

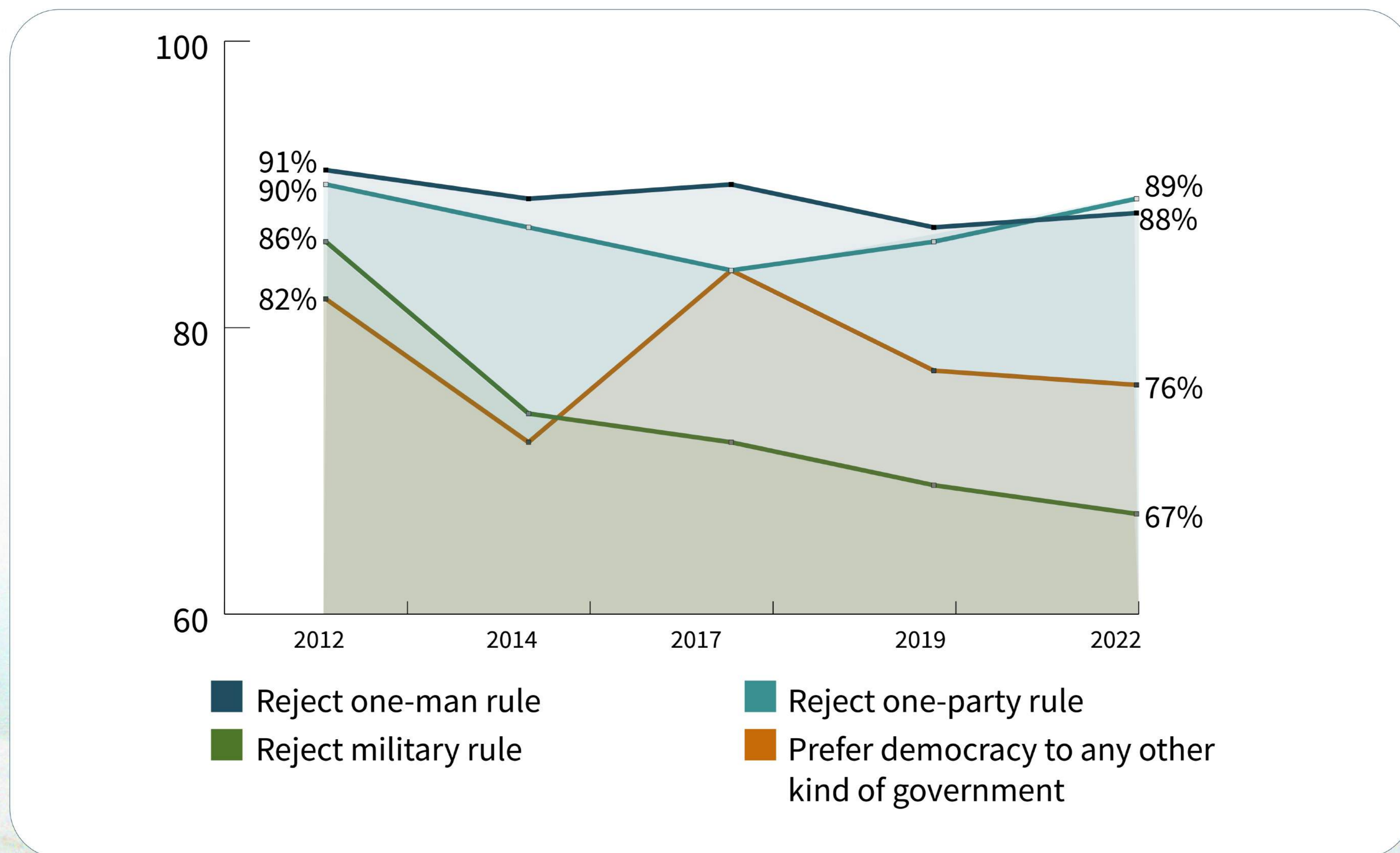
